Costume Plot for *Les Miserables*

Jean Valjean:

- 1) Torn muslin shirt w/#24601 patch, torn muslin pants, cap
- 2) Overcoat or cape coat \$40.00
- 3) Dark frock coat, vest, shirt, dress pants, cravat, top hat
- 4) Uniform jacket \$50.00
- 5) Tailcoat option for wedding \$50.00

Inspector Javert:

- 1) Uniform jacket, Pants, bicorn hat w/plume, boot covers
- 2) Disguise overcoat, tricorne hat \$55.00

Bishop of Digne:

Bishop's cassock, hat, under dress, drape

Fantine:

- 1) Period cotton dress, apron, mob cap
- 2) Corset, skirt, crinoline, shawl, fetching bonnet, bloomers
- 3) White nightgown \$30.00

Young Cosette:

- 1) Ragged smock dress, pinafore, mob cap, bloomers
- 2) Upper Class Period dress w/lace collar, bonnet

Cosette:

- 1) Period dress w/lace collar, bonnet
- 2) Wedding gown, hoop (for skirt), veil \$85.00

Young Eponine:

Period dress, bonnet, bloomers

Eponine:

- 1) Worn peasant blouse/corset, skirt, crinoline, cap
- 2) Pants, peasant shirt, long overcoat, cap, fingerless gloves
- 3) Bloody peasant shirt \$25.00

Thernardier:

- 1) Knickers, shirt, scarf, ragged coat, apron, hat, vest socks & boot tops
- 2) Overcoat or hooded cloak \$45.00
- 3) Wedding option: Loud Colonial coat, knickers, vest, ruffled jabot shirt, knee socks, shoe buckles

Madame Thernardier:

- 1) Skirt, bloomers, peasant blouse, waist cinch, apron, mob cap, fingerless gloves
- 2) Period dress, ragged shawl, bonnet
- 3) Wedding option: Loud period dress, crinoline/hoop, gloves, pearls/choker, headpiece

Marius:

- 1) Tailcoat, pants, ruffled shirt, vest, cravat, Red, white, blue sash & button
- 2) Black tailcoat, pants, white vest, shirt, cravat
- 3) *Caped overcoat* \$40.00

Gavroche:

Tattered pants, peasant/pirate shirt, vest, scarf, cap, fingerless gloves

Enjolras:

Red military vest, trousers, L/S shirt with jabot or cravat, Red, White, Blue Sash & button

(Thernardier gang) Brujon:

Knickers, peasant shirt, vest, belt, cap

(Thernardier gang) Babet:

Ragged tailcoat, pants, shirt, vest, ragged top hat

(Thernardier gang) Claquesous:

Pants, peasant/pirate shirt, vest, coat, hat

(W/Thernardier) Montparnasse:

Tailcoat, shirt, vest, pants/knickers, jabot, top hat

Bamatabois:

Tailcoat, shirt, vest, pants/knickers, jabot, top hat

Major Domo:

Dark pants, shirt, vest, jabot, tailcoat

Foreman:

Pants, peasant/pirate shirt, vest, jacket

Convicts:

Torn muslin shirts, ragged pants, caps, belts, cut off gloves

Soldiers/Constables:

Blue/red uniform coats with attached dickie, knickers, boot tops, bicorn/tricorne hats

Judge: \$45.00

Judge's robe & gavel

Nuns:

Robe, wimple, headpiece, collar, cross

Student Revolutionaries:

Assorted pants, shirts, vests, jackets, cravats, red-white-blue sash
(some will receive buttons – others may not)

Bishop's Sister:

- 1) Period dress, cap or bonnet,
- 2) Nightgown and shawl \$40.00

(Drink w/Me) Innkeeper:

Pants, peasant/pirate shirt, apron, cap

Sailors on the docks

Sailor pants, sailor shirt, sailor cap, neckerchief

Travelers:

Overcoats, shirts, pants/knickers, vests, top hats, mufflers

Inn Patrons:

Men: Peasant/pirate shirts, pants, vests, jackets, caps

Women: Skirts-peasant blouses or dresses, shawls or jackets, aprons, some crinolines, bonnets or mob caps

Each dressed differently so no two look exactly alike

Farm Workers:

Men: Peasant shirts, pants, straw hats, rope belts, vests

Women: Skirts, peasant blouses, jackets, straw hats

Each dressed differently so no two look exactly alike

Unemployed Ensemble/ Beggars:

Male: Pants, torn peasant shirts, ragged jackets, scarves, caps, fingerless gloves

Female: Ragged skirts, blouses, shawls, scarves, fingerless gloves, mob caps

****Each dressed differently so no two look exactly alike****

Factory Workers & General Ensemble:

Male: Peasant/pirate shirts, jackets, vests, pants, caps

Female: Dress or Skirt & blouse; shawls & aprons, caps or bonnets

Brothel Workers:

Female: Assorted Skirts, some crinolines, bodices or corsets, bloomers, some peasant blouses, Waist cinches, gloves, boas, shawls or coats

Male: Worn but fancy jackets, shirts, vests, pants, cravats

Wedding Guests:

Men: Black tailcoats, shirts, dress pants, white vests, cravats

Women: Hoop gowns, headpieces, gloves

****Each dressed differently so no two look exactly alike****

Additional: Top Hats, \$10.00

Barrier Spray available (\$13.99)-keep make-up on the actors and off the costumes.

Special Notes:

All costumes are based on our interpretation. At times, it may be necessary to send costumes that are not exactly what is described, due to sizing or availability but we guarantee that costumes will suit the character.

For local shows, an on-site visit by a costumer is available (3 choices):

1. Costumer views cast in costume and makes minor adjustments - \$200 for 2 hours (Nassau & Western Suffolk). \$250 for 2 hours (Eastern Suffolk and Queens).
2. Costumer measures cast a min. of 8 weeks before dress rehearsal (see above prices).
3. Combo – both visits for \$350 (Nassau/Western Suffolk), \$450 (Eastern Suffolk/Queens).

For local shows, costumes may be delivered and picked up by store employees for an additional fee (\$50 for Nassau/Western Suffolk each way. \$85.00 each way Eastern Suffolk and Queens).

Prices quoted are for up to 2 weeks out of shop. Additional time is at pro-rated costs:
3rd week ½ rate, 4th week ¼ rate.

All shipping costs out and back are in addition to costume rates and will be added to the final bill before shipping (once costumes are bagged, boxed and weighed).
